

## Guidelines for your submission and the template

The template has the size DIN A4.

The standard font for conference documents is "ARIAL", general font size is "10".

The proposal should have a minimum size of 2 pages.

The file size should not exceed 1MB

### Submission

Submissions will be treated confidential until the proposal is accepted by the programme committee.

No similar proposal should have been published!

Please be aware that your abstracts, if chosen by the programme committee, will be made available on our conference web site as additional information (PDF file) for our conference participants.

You automatically agree to the publishing at our websites and in the conference proceedings unless you provide an updated version.

### Title

Please choose a meaningful title which attracts the audience.

It should not exceed the maximum of 90 characters (incl. spaces).

### Authors/Presenter

The speaker of the presentation should be mentioned first.

Beside the complete name (first name and surname) please mention your title, company and country code.

All other authors involved in the proposal but not supporting the presentation onsite can be introduced with "further authors".

Just for your information: Only the main speaker of an accepted presentation will receive the concessions.

#### *Workshop*

Workshops are planned from 30<sup>th</sup> to 31<sup>st</sup> October 2008. They offer participants a small group, where they can share ideas and learn from each other. The limited attendance allows more interaction. They are scheduled for 90 minutes.

#### *Tutorial*

The tutorials (full-day or half-day) take place in preparation to the conference on 29<sup>th</sup> October 2008 in the Crowne Plaza Hotel Canberra. We are looking for presentations that will provide delegates with an overview of real life project experiences or software challenges. The tutorials should cover the same topics as planned for the conference.

#### *Presentation (Academic presentations respectively Industrial project papers)*

Presentations are planned during the conference (30<sup>th</sup> to 31<sup>st</sup> October 2008) and will take place in the National Convention Centre Canberra. They are scheduled for 40 minutes.

These presentations should give a detailed insight into methods and tools used in project work and lessons learned. Research results are also of interest in this category.

## Abstract

Industrial papers – It should be clearly stated which challenges have been managed and please describe the success or failure in doing so. Especially the conclusions should be addressed.

Academic papers – In addition the abstract should state the methodic background, reference to state-of-the-art in research and development, the effect of the results and future development.

Please also include...

- The profit for the audience
- Conclusions
- List of references
- Which tools and methods have been in use
- Duration and actual situation of the project
- Examples

Sales demonstrations of services or tools will not be accepted. Exhibition and product presentation may be used for that kind of presentations.
